1. Join Your Class

- 1 Open the Liquid Football link your teacher gives you.
- 2 Choose **Join a Classroom**.
- 3 Enter the Class Code exactly. Enter the Class Key only if your teacher says one is required.
- 4 Choose **Enter Class & Play**. No student email or password is required for the classroom workflow.

YOUR QUESTIONS

Your teacher's curriculum replaces the standard trivia bank. Each correct answer earns +10 Trivia Points and +10 management interactions.

2. Your Weekly Routine

Step	Weekly Area	What to do
1	Schedule	Review the opponent, location, current record and season context.
2	Trivia	Answer the available weekly questions. Correct answers add to Trivia Points and the Interaction Bank.
3	Academics	Check GPA, eligibility and degree progress before planning the rest of the week.
4	Team Training	Use the scouting information and complete the weekly team preparation plan.
5	Individual Training	Use banked interactions selectively to develop specific players.
6	Recruiting	Recruit future players and handle eligible roster-management decisions.
7	Depth Chart	Place the best eligible players in the roles you want to use.
8	Simulate Game	Play the live simulation and respond to coaching decisions when they appear.
9	Advance Week	Review the result and statistics, save if needed, then move to the next week.

Your teacher may have you stop at a certain point, discuss decisions as a class, or wait before advancing the week. Follow your teacher's instructions.

3. The Main Systems You Will See

System	What you are managing
Academics	GPA, eligibility and degree progress.
Team Training	A 30-hour weekly preparation plan.
Individual Training	Player development using management interactions.
Recruiting	Future roster building and prospect interest.
Depth Chart / Rotation	Which eligible players will fill game roles.
GIS	Fictional schools, hometowns, recruits, players and travel/recruiting context.
Budget / Program	Travel, meals, recruiting, sponsorships and other enabled systems.

System	What you are managing
Coach Status	Security and Reputation are shown together for convenience but remain separate measures.

4. Keep Your Classroom Session

- Use the same browser and device when you return whenever possible.
- Use the same browser and device each time you return to the classroom game whenever possible.
- Make sure you are entering the same Class Code before continuing.
- If anything looks wrong, stop before advancing the week and ask your teacher.

5. If You Cannot Join

Problem	What to do
Class Code does not work	Check the code with your teacher.
Class Key does not work	Ask your teacher whether the key is required and verify it.
No questions appear	Tell your teacher so the class question bank can be checked.
Classroom session error	Reload the page and try again. If it continues, tell your teacher.

REMEMBER

Classroom Mode changes the questions, not the management game. Use what you know from class to earn more resources and make better program decisions.
